# **Procedures for One to One Teaching** and Guidance Activities

#### **Aims**

• To provide clear guidelines for all concerned parties regarding the provision of one-to-one teaching and guidance for students.

#### Guidelines

- One-to-one teaching and guidance takes place in the Learning Support Room/Guidance Counsellors Room/a classroom that have a glass viewing pane, or in a public area.
- The teacher should be positioned facing the door.
- To provide privacy for the student, they should sit with their back to the door.
- Where the above guidelines are not possible it is recommended that the door to the room remain open, for transparency for both parties.
